Empower South Sudanese youth program will build relationships and capacity in young people of the Victorian South Sudanese community who are at risk interacting with the justice system.

There will be a focus on early intervention to deter South Sudanese young people interacting with the justice system.

The Youth Workers will engage young people through informal community networks; youth services departments, school welfare coordinators and partner organisations.

Empower South Sudanese Youth Wellbeing have partner with local government services, community organisations, members of the South Sudanese community and Victoria Police to deliver the program.

A Youth Worker will work closely with Wyndham City Council and Brimbank City Council to engage with 50 participants each year.
